
Nature's Exquisite Simplicity

It's a simple, elegant logic. From one, many spring. From the ground, a sapling emerges. Branches grow. Leaves sprout. Flowers bloom. A cycle begins. The branching pattern is an apt metaphor for a growing family, and at Belle Vue Residences, the renowned Japanese architect Toyo Ito has made it the heart of his design.

The design of Belle Vue Residences parallels nature's exquisite simplicity, Located on high ground in the city centre, it personifies the harmonious relationship between man and nature. On sprawling ground of almost 250,000 sq ft, 176 imaginatively-configured apartments are set in a lush naturalistic landscape, creating perhaps Singapore's most livable urban oasis.







Branching Motif

Belle Vue Residences is inspired by nature's growth pattern and an elegant composition of branches. To architect Toyo Ito, these are the fundamental forms that would define his design for Belle Vue Residences. The branching motif is a recurring theme in his expression of a new urban lifestyle "in the trees" that is in tune with life in modern, tropical Singapore.

Belle Vue Residences' organically-shaped plan offers many advantages. The branching pattern gives each apartment a unique set of views. It also creates more wall surfaces that face outwards, making possible a greater number of windows. This in turn provides residents with abundant natural light and better ventilation. Coupled with a well-planned layout, Ito's branching motif truly brings about a whole new spatial and living experience.

The Architect

Nature is a perpetual inspiration for architect Toyo Ito, whose lyrical free-flowing spaces and designs mirror the rhythms and patterns of organic growth. "Good design means not to design, not to make shapes deliberately." Ito's reverence for the naturally-evolved form is a well-documented design approach, and informs his entire creative output that today includes lighting systems, bookshelves, tableware and bathroom accessories.

One of the world's most respected architects, Ito is known to be highly selective of his commissions. His most celebrated works include White U, Silver Hut – house of the architect, Tower of Winds, Sendai Mediatheque, TOD'S Omotesando Building, VivoCity in Singapore, Tama Art University Library (Hachioji campus), etc. Some of his many current works, including Taichung Metropolitan Opera House, Extension for "The Fair of Barcelona Gran Via Venue" (Spain), University of California, Berkeley Art Museum and Pacific Film Archive (U.S.A.), are under development.

Mr. Ito has been honored with many awards, including Architectural Institute of Japan Prize, Japan Art Academy Prize, Golden Lion for Lifetime Achievement from the 8th International Architecture Exhibition "NEXT" at the Venice Biennale, ADI Compasso d'Oro Award, Royal Gold Medal from The Royal Institute of British Architects, 6th Austrian Frederick Kiesler Prize for Architecture and the Arts.

Belle Vue Residences is inspired by nature, but it is also as much about transcending trends, surmount conventional ideas and creating innovative living spaces. At the heart of Belle Vue Residences' most original design is the branching pattern that personifies the nature's life force. Through architect Toyo Ito, nature artistry has been mindfully translated into a haven for living, learning, work and play.







A Harmonious Landscape

At Belle Vue Residences, the landscaping is an active interplay of nature and architecture. The large number of windows on all sides of the apartments draw in nature and create a feeling of harmony with the surrounding gardens. This soothing greenery also acts as a screen to provide residents a sense of privacy amid the open architecture. The nine apartment blocks, built to a comforting human scale, rise gently in a sensitively-cultivated environment of pathways, tropical gardens and water features.





Central Courtyard & Facilities

The lush, naturalistic landscape at Belle Vue Residences brings architect Toyo Ito's concept of a thriving ecosystem to the fore. The interior and exterior spaces are seamlessly integrated: the buildings – the "trunks and branches" – are trailed by meandering pathways in the surrounding gardens that lead to various recreational facilities. Amid this landscape of reflecting pools, water wall and water features, residents will find public activity areas such as the clubhouse, swimming pools, jacuzzi pool, BBQ area and children's playground a most thoughtful complement.






Clubhouse & Courtyard Garden

A visual focus of the landscape around Belle Vue Residences is the two-storey clubhouse, Designed as a bridge over landscaped pools, it features a viewing veranda, multi-purpose function room, leisure lounge and theatrette. At the lower level, the gymnasium and relaxation fover look out to an elegant courtyard garden animated by a cascading water wall, giving residents a soothing view as they keep in shape or enjoy their moment of blissful solitude.


